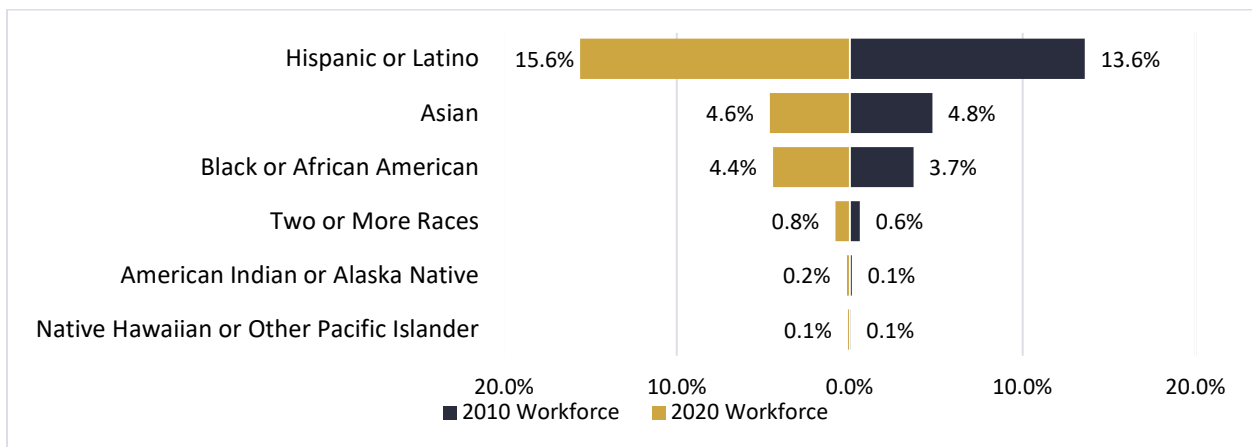


Errata Statement from Points Consulting

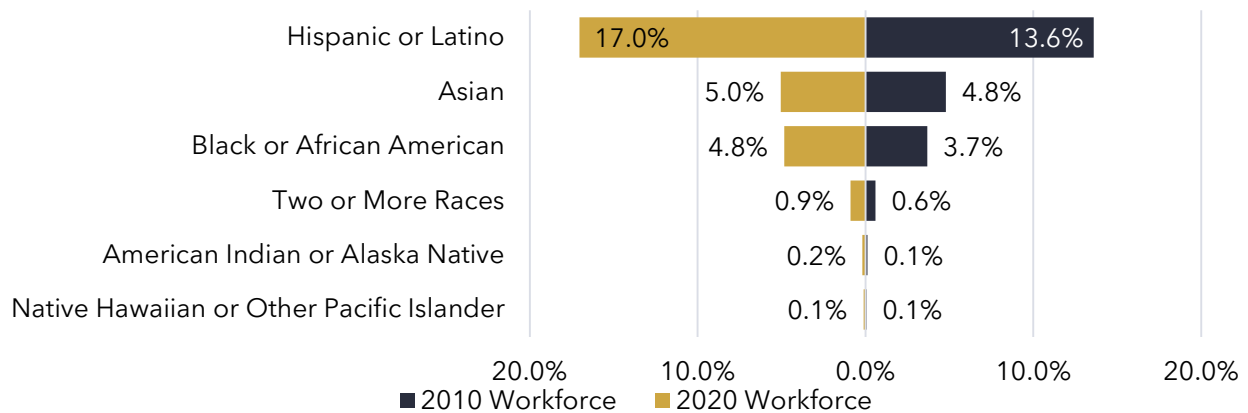

Points Consulting makes note of a mistake in the original version of the *State of Rhode Island Manufacturing 2022* report. Originally stated is “In 2010, females composed 32.9% of the workforce, which dropped to 29.2% by 2020.” These numbers were incorrect, though the story remains the same. Instead, PC finds that “In 2010, females composed 32.9% of the workforce, which dropped to 31.9% by 2020.” — a decrease of 1% rather than 3%.

In addition to this, the chart depicting “Manufacturing Workforce Diversity Over Time (2010 V. 2020)” originally displayed as such:



The chart has been updated, now displaying:



In total, manufacturing workforce diversity in Rhode Island increased from 2010 to 2020 by 5.2%.
